3. Continue (N) on Mt Read to Latta Rd. Turn Rt (E) on Latta to the Parkway. Continue (E) on the parkway and continue across the new O'Rourke Bridge. After crossing the bridge turn Rt (S) on Thomas Av. to Eaton St. Turn Lt (E) on Eaton to Rock Beach Rd. Turn Rt (S) on Rock Beach to Lake Lea Rd. Turn Lt (E) on Lake Lea to # 144

4. Continue (E) on Lake Lea Rd. to Colebrook Rd. Turn Lt (N) on Colebrook to Lake Shore Blvd. Turn Rt (E) on Lake Shore to Kings Highway. Turn Rt (S) on Kings Hwy to 104 Expressway (East). Travel east on the Expressway to Rte 250 exit (Webster or Nine Mile Point Rd approximately 8 mi). Turn Rt (S) on 250 to Rte 31F, Church St in Fairport (approximately 8 1/2 mi). Turn Lt (E) on 31F to Turk Hill Rd. Turn Rt (S) on Turk Hill to Pebble Hill Rd. Turn Lt (E) on Pebble Hill to Bridgewood Dr. Turn Rt (E) on Bridgewood to # 20
